DAY 01 & 02 TARANGIRE TREETOPS, TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

Tarangire Treetops is located in a private conservancy on the edge of Tarangire National Park, with easy access to both the Park and the conservancy. The area is known for its many elephant herds and giant Baobab trees. Each of the rooms is elevated above the ground which allows for spectacular views over the marula and baobab trees across the Tarangire plains. All 20 rooms have large bedrooms with en-suite bathrooms which are equipped with double showers. With comfortable spacious rooms, wonderful service and beautiful views across Tarangire, a great start to your safari.





DAY 03 & 04 THE MANOR, NGORONGORO HIGHLANDS

The Manor at Ngorongoro, located in the north west Tanzania and with its 10 luxurious cottages (20 Suites) and magnificent main Manor House, is one of the first safari lodges of its kind to blend East African hospitality with old-world Afro-European architecture and decor. Located adjacent to the famous Ngorongoro conservation area and within a 1500- acre Arabica coffee estate, The Manor is reminiscent of an elegant up-country farm home in the Cape Dutch-style of architecture. The Manor provides the perfect environment to relax and take in the outstanding natural beauty of its gardens and the coffee-bush laden hills.



DAY TRIP NGORONGORO CRATER

Ngorongoro Crater is a geological spectacle - a 260 square kilometre caldera which was formed three million years ago when a giant active volcano exploded and collapsed about 3 million years ago and was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1978. Today it's a wildlife haven for lion, elephant, hyena, buffalo, large herds of wildebeest and zebra and the highly endangered black rhino and many other species living on the mineral rich pastures of the largely flat crater floor.



DAY 05 - 07 PIONEER CAMP, SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

Located in South Central Serengeti, within the Moru Kopjes area, Serengeti Pioneer Camp is ideally situated to offer superlative access to the annual migration and the 'Big 5' with sweeping views overlooking Moru Kopjes, Lake Magadi and the endless plains. Serengeti Pioneer follows the feel and style of the mobile camps of the 1930's, a time when an African safari was truly a journey into the unknown. Comprising of ten-tented accommodations, all of which have en-suite facilities including a flushing toilet, vanity basin, and showers, the tent interiors are designed to evoke the very best of an era long-gone but certainly not forgotten.





DAY 08 DEPARTURE

Sadly, it is the end of your Safari, Fly back to Kilimanjaro Airport for your onwards journey.
